- Representative body of EU Wine Companies
- Representing still wines, sparkling wines, liqueur wines and aromatised wine products
- 21 national associations
- Observers from Switzerland and Ukraine

A pillar of the EU agricultural economy

- **70%** of the global wine production in value
- **63%** of global wine production in volume
- 1st EU agri-product exported in 2017
- € 100 billion estimated market value

With a crucial socio-economic role

- 3.362.000 ha of vineyard surface
- **1750** PDO or PGI
 - 63%: part of EU wines protected by a GI
- 2.400.000 million wine holdings
- 3.000.000 million direct full-time jobs

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In the framework of the <u>EU Public Health policy</u> and for the first time ever, the European Commission adopted in October 2006 a specific EU Strategy to Support Member States in reducing alcohol-related harm.

With the firm intention of promoting responsible and moderate wine drinking as a social and cultural norm, the whole European wine sector (CEEV, COPA-COGECA, CEVI) united and launched a programme called "Wine in Moderation - Art de Vivre" as the wine sector's tangible and measurable commitment to the EAHF





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During the whole period 2008-2010, CEEV was the leader of the Wine in Moderation Programme and the owner of the Wine in Moderation – Art de Vivre commitment to the European Alcohol and Health Forum (EAHF). In 2011, CEEV hugely supported the establishment of the WiM Association, to which it passed the coordination of the Programme.

Today, CEEV remains owner of the commitment to the EAHF and a key member of the WiM Association providing guidance, raising awareness on the performance of the Programme to its stakeholders and supporting the growth of Wine in Moderation.
