Why focus on children on holiday abroad?

- We drink more while children are present during summer holidays than any other time of year
- Children are more vulnerable
 - lose their network of security (teachers, grand parents, kind neighbours)
 - They don't know the language
 - They have no escape route
- Chose to focus on all inclusive holidays because
 - They are particularly popular amongst families with young children





What's the problem?



What do the parents say?

- 41 % have seen Norwegian adults intoxicated while they were on holiday abroad with children
- 19% have seen Norwegian kids feeling clearly uncomfortable because their parents were drinking too much on a holiday abroad
- 27 % say that they drink more alcohol when they stay at an all inclusive hotel compared to a hotel where alcohol is not included in the price
- 16% feel the tour operators do not work hard enough to prevent adults from drinking too much around children






What about the children?

- 25 % of the kids say their parents drink more alcohol when they are on holiday together than during the rest of the year
- 18% have wished that their parents would drink less alcohol on holidays while they were present
- 18 % have experienced what they would describe as «a very uncomfortable or scary» situation because there parents were drinking too much alcohol









How did the tour operators respond?




1. Guidelines – Yes! We have those!
